



**Announcement of the Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music
Portfolio 1B for the Bachelor of Music Program,
School of Music, Academic Year 2025**

The Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music invites applications for the Portfolio 1B to the Bachelor of Music degree, School of Music, for Academic Year 2026. The application and selection period runs from **24 November 2025 to 10 January 2026**.

1. Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet all of the following conditions:

- 1.1. Graduated from or expecting to graduate from Mathayom 6 (or equivalent).
- 1.2. Cumulative GPA (GPAX) of at least 2.00 over four semesters.
- 1.3. For US GED holders: minimum score of 145 per subject and total score of at least 640.
- 1.4. Demonstrated proficiency on the primary instrument, sufficient theoretical knowledge of Western music and music history, and aural skills appropriate for undergraduate study.
- 1.5. Commitment to music study, awareness of contemporary developments, and understanding of music's role in Thai, ASEAN, and international contexts.
- 1.6. Proficiency on a secondary instrument (e.g. Thai instruments, ASEAN instruments, electric instruments) will receive special consideration.
- 1.7. No health condition or illness that may affect academic performance or professional practice.
- 1.8. Compliance with all additional requirements in the Institute's regulations..

2. Required Documents

Applicants must upload the following to the PGVIM Admission system

(<http://www.pgvim.ac.th/admission/>):

- 2.1. **Portfolio** in the Institute's prescribed format, including a QR code linking to unedited YouTube videos that:
 - 2.1.1. Follow the repertoire list on the PGVIM Admission website.
 - 2.1.2. Show the performer's face and technique clearly, recorded continuously without editing.
 - 2.1.3. Portfolios will not be returned.
- 2.2. Statement of Purpose
- 2.3. Official transcripts for four semesters.
- 2.4. Any additional documentation as specified on the PGVIM Admission website.

3. Evaluation and Scoring

The Admissions Committee will assign up to 100 points as follows:

- 3.1. GPAX (4 semesters): 10 points
- 3.2. Portfolio: 20 points
- 3.3. Statement of Purpose: 10 points
- 3.4. Practical Examination: 30 points
- 3.5. Interview: 30 points

4. Application Submission and Notification

- 4.1. Applicants must verify their eligibility and review all admission requirements for the Bachelor of Music program on the PGVIM Admission website. Any candidate found to be ineligible at any point, even after passing the entrance examinations, will be disqualified without refund.
- 4.2. Eligible applicants must complete the online application via the PGVIM Admission website, providing accurate information and uploading all required documents. Incomplete or incorrect submissions may be corrected by the applicant within the official application period; failure to do so before the deadline will render the application invalid.
- 4.3. Applicants must pay a non-refundable application fee of THB 2,000 by bank transfer to Krung Thai Bank, Arunnamarin Intersection Branch, Account No. 157-0-26285-3 (Account Name: Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music). Proof of payment must be uploaded to the PGVIM Admission system.
- 4.4. The list of candidates eligible for interview and audition will be published on the PGVIM Admission website on **16 January 2026**.

5. Interview and Audition

The Admissions Committee will conduct both interview and audition on **23 January 2026** which include:

- 5.1. **Interview:** Study attitude, problem-solving skills, English communication, general music knowledge (theory and history), and any relevant special skills (e.g. music technology).
- 5.2. **Practical Audition:** Technical exercises and repertoire on the primary instrument, as specified by the Institute.

6. Agreement Acknowledgment and Clearing-house Confirmation

- 6.1. The list of successful candidates will be announced on PGVIM Admission website on **30 January 2026**
- 6.2. Candidates must appear in person at the Institute on **2 February 2026** to acknowledge terms and proceed to Clearing-house confirmation.
- 6.3. Candidates must confirm their place in the TCAS Clearing-house system on **6–7 February 2026** (<https://student.mytcas.com/>). Failure to do so by the deadline constitutes forfeiture of admission. Only one update to the confirmation is permitted.

7. Final Admission and Registration

7.1. The list of admitted students will be published on **13 February 2026**.

7.2. Admitted students must complete registration by **20 February 2026**.

7.3. Registration fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.

8. Scholarships

Admitted students may apply for Institute scholarships by submitting the required forms on the day of registration.

9. Orientation

The Student Affairs Office will schedule orientation for mid-July 2026. Details will be provided at registration.
