Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music Announcement  
Application for three positions of foreign lecturer

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The Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music in Bangkok, Thailand invites applicants for a one semester contract foreign lecturer position with a possibility to extend to one academic year. The expected starting date is July 20, 2020 but no later than August 10, 2020. This position will be contracted under School of Music with a negotiable salary candidates' working experiences and qualifications.

**1. General Qualifications**

- 1.1 This application is open for any foreign nationalities.
- 1.2 At least 3 years of teaching experience in the university level.
- 1.3 Thorough knowledge of the music literature.
- 1.4 Interested in and able to work across disciplines.
- 1.5 Able to collaborate well with colleagues
- 1.6 Responsible for the job assigned and consist of a strong work ethic.

**2. Specific Qualifications**

**Position 1: Foreign Lecturer in Cello Performance**

- Must hold a doctoral degree in cello *or*
- A master degree in cello with at least 5 years experience in professional performance *or*
- A master degree with at least an assistant professorship in cello

**Position 2: Foreign Lecturer in Bassoon Performance**

- Must hold a doctoral degree in bassoon *or*
- A master degree in bassoon with at least 5 years experience in professional performance *or*
- A master degree with at least an assistant professorship in bassoon

**Position 3: Foreign Lecturer in Research or Artistic Research**

- Must hold a doctoral degree *or*
- A master degree with at least an associate professorship in music *and*
- Published at least 3 researches, articles, or creative works within the past 5 years.

### 3. Responsibilities

#### Position 1: Foreign Lecturer in Cello Performance

- Act as ambassador of Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music to promote the program and to develop student's skills to the highest level possible.
- Teach a studio of cello for Bachelor of Music program and/or Master of Music program.
- Coach chamber music for Bachelor of Music program.
- Teach courses in other areas such as music pedagogy, music history or music theory as determined by the candidates' qualifications and the needs of the school.
- Develop a plan for student recruitment.
- Maintain an active performance career.
- Support and reinforce PGVIM's commitment to social outreach and artistic innovation through teaching, performance, and research activities.
- Work collaboratively with other faculty members and staff to organize and run events such as career training workshops, project week activities, and the annual International Symposium.

#### Position 2: Foreign Lecturer in Bassoon Performance

- Act as ambassador of Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music to promote the program and to develop student's skills to the highest level possible.
- Teach a studio of bassoon for Bachelor of Music program and/or Master of Music program.
- Teach courses in other areas such as music pedagogy, music history or music theory as determined by the candidates' qualifications and the needs of the school.

- Develop a plan for student recruitment.
- Maintain an active performance career.

- Work collaboratively with other faculty members and staff to organize and run events such as career training workshops, project week activities, and the annual International Symposium.

**3. Application Period and Procedure**

3.2 The deadline of application is 22 June 2020.

3.3 The list of qualified candidates will be announced within one week of the application deadline and the candidates will be contacted for an interview at the same time.

3.4 The interview, which might include a short performance, a mock teaching, or a research/project presentation, will be held by the first week of July.

3.5 The successful candidates' announcement will be made by 13 July 2020.
