VISITING LECTURER (Collaborative Piano)

Princess Galyani Vadhana Institute of Music (PGVIM) is seeking a qualified and enthusiastic individual to join the School of Music as a Visiting Lecturer in Collaborative Piano. The position is a contract of up to 10 months and reports to the Dean of the School of Music, with a starting date in July 2025. This position is <u>open to international applicants only</u> and is suitable for individuals currently enrolled in a doctoral program in music or those seeking to build their teaching portfolio at the college level.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach, manage, coordinate, and develop collaborative piano courses for the Bachelor of Music program.
- Organize and assign collaborative pianists to support students in the Bachelor of Music program.
- 3. Perform as a collaborative pianist for students in the Bachelor of Music program.
- 4. Conduct and present or publish research, creative works, or academic documents at least once a year.
- 5. Oversee projects assigned by the School of Music or the Institute.
- 6. Perform other tasks as assigned.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

The candidate should:

- 1. Demonstrate at least three years of teaching experience at the higher education level.
- 2. Possess a strong passion for teaching and student development.
- 3. Be capable of mentoring student projects and providing effective instruction in individual, group, and classroom settings.
- 4. Be willing and able to collaborate across different fields of study.
- 5. Exhibit a growth mindset and a commitment to achieving goals to fulfill job responsibilities effectively.
- 6. Demonstrate a strong work ethic, clear communication skills, and empathy to foster effective collaboration with colleagues.

- 7. Uphold high ethical standards in teaching, research, and related work.
- 8. Have experience managing and executing music-related projects and activities.
- 9. Show the ability to generate and implement ideas and projects aligned with PGVIM's vision and mission.

SPECIFIC QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. The candidate must hold a master's degree or be currently enrolled in a doctoral program focusing on collaborative piano or piano performance.
- 2. The candidate should have a proven track record of professional experience at national or international levels.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 2. The list of eligible candidates for presentation and interview will be announced by the second week of April 2025.

PRESENTATION AND INTERVIEW

- 1. Conduct a 15-minute mock teaching session on a topic of your choice for the committee.
- 2. Deliver a 15-minute presentation on a plan to implement collaborative piano to the program.
- 3. Present a 15-minute research proposal, emphasizing its relevance and potential impact in alignment with PGVIM's mission.
- 4. Participate in a 15-minute interview with the committee.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

- 1. The base salary starts at 23,800 THB, which may be adjusted based on relevant experience.
- 2. Group insurance benefits will be provided to the successful candidate by PGVIM.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Completed application form provided by PGVIM.
- 2. One 3x4 cm photograph taken within the last six months, showing the applicant with a neutral expression, facing straight at the camera.
- 3. Copy of degree certification(s) or equivalent document(s).
- 4. Copy of higher education transcripts.
- 5. Copy of passport and/or national identification card.
- 6. One-page cover letter describing your interest in the position, relevant experience, and qualifications.
- 7. Statement of teaching philosophy.
- 8. Curriculum Vitae (CV).

- 9. Three letters of reference.
- 10. Web link to at least one video recording of a recent live performance or artistic research presentation.
- 11. Copies of journal articles or creative works (if available).
- 12. English proficiency test results (except for native English speakers or applicants who have earned their doctoral degree in an English-speaking country).
- 13. Application fee of 100 THB per application.

Note: The successful candidate will be required to submit a medical certificate.
